<u>Club Finish Line Sign</u> - Tim has a preliminary design and pricing on two inflatable start/finish line archways, to replace our broken and potentially dangerous start/finish line. Tim provided copies of (2) quotes with preliminary proofs of graphics. The club voted to approve a \$4,000 budget. Tim will finalize design and send it to club officers for final approval to purchase.

<u>Race Permit</u> - The permit was completed for our 2023 race and submitted to the PM Site Superintendent, followed closely by the required Permit fee.

<u>Certificate of Insurance</u> - The COI for our 2023 race was received and submitted to the PM Site Superintendent.

<u>Proposed Race Change Discussion</u> - Tim/Jeff presented some ideas.

- Delete the post-race awards ceremony.
 - >25% of \$2,200 in awards go unclaimed.
 - o Save \$650 on keg beer cost. Add beer to outside.
 - Save \$400 on music costs.
 - Add cost to rent sound system for lodge announcements.
 - o Retain pre-race use of lodge with coffee at \$500 cost.

The consensus was to leave the band, beer, and awards in the lodge one more year and try to do a better job of informing people about

the awards ceremony. Possibly put a laptop near the finish so people would know they won an award.

- Change awards to 10-year age groups from 5-year.
 The consensus was to leave at 5-year for 2023.
- Opt out of SWAG option at registration.
 This was approved if Tim and Jeff decide it doesn't cause other issues.
