Pere Marquette Trail Race Report:

- <u>Final Registration Number/Actual Attendees</u> 443, which includes 7 sponsor entries.
- <u>Budget Summary</u> Tim reported that he and Jeff were able to shave quite a bit of costs this year to the tune of approximately \$4,500. The total income from the race was \$23,261, and the total expenditures was \$16,525, making our profit \$6,737.

Runners were again generous and donated \$1,875 above the registration fees. A motion was made to round up to \$2,000, which passed, so we will donate \$2,000 to the Friends of Pere Marquette for trail/park maintenance.
