  - 439 finishers (255 women, 184 men)
3. 11/26/09 – Turkey Trot/Cocoa Arts 5K – Cocoa Beach
  - 449 finishers [496 timed]
  - ran out of cards (not using Henry Campbell system)
  - clock failed
4. 11/26/09 – Suntree Turkey Trot 5K – Suntree
  - 497 finishers
    - 10K: 80 finishers (50 women, 30 men)
    - 5K: 417 finishers (234 women, 183 men)
5. 11/29/09 – Space Coast Marathon & Half-Marathon – Cocoa/Rockledge – SCR #3
  - 2129 finishers (over 2400 registered)
    - Marathon: 666 finishers (384 women, 282 men)
    - Half-Marathon: 1463 finishers (858 women, 605 men)

  - 1063 finishers (550 women, 513 men) [1185 registered]

  - Board decided that it would be more efficient to have separate award ceremonies for the 2-mile and 10K.
